The 2009 South East Queensland Titles were held in conjunction with Darling Point's GRFC (Get Ready for Christmas) regatta. Nine 125's faced the starters gun for the 4 SEQ races on Saturday and Sunday and 4 GRFC races on Monday.

Shake 'n' Bake skippered by James Chilman and crewed by Lauren Robba showed a clean pair of heels in most races with **Oddly Enough** (Vicky Callow and Grant Steinback) and **Accelerando** (Emma Turner and Ashley Hoffman) fighting it out for the minor placings. The standard of racing was high for all of the races with a number of boats winning heats (only after a rare mistake by **Shake 'n' Bake**)

A number of boats benefited from a mid regatta tune up. **Osterly** (LHCSC crew of Hannah Ruedinger and Ashley McAuliffe) gave us a scare on Monday after I spent time tuning their boat (I hope you took notes girls). **Magpie** (Ian Kennedy and his son) had a late regatta charge thanks to a new second hand jib (thanks Lyn Hanlon).

QUEENSLAND 125 CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

EASTER REGATTA

Entries are invited for the 2010 Queensland Championships for the 125 Class, to be conducted by the Queensland Division of the 125 Association and the Maryborough Sailing Club, from the 2nd to the 4th of April 2010.

LOCATION

The Maryborough Sailing Club is situated on Scarness esplanade, Hervey Bay (next door to the Scarness Caravan Park) and is later referred to as Race Headquarters in this Notice of Regatta.

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Safety Regulations of the Australian Yachting Federation and the Class Rules of the 125 Association, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

The A.Y.F Safety Regulations, Addendum "A", Part 2 shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to enter, the following must apply:

a) The boat and equipment shall comply with the Rules of Construction and Measurement of the 125 Class Dinghy and hold a current measurement Certificate. Measurement Certificates are to be presented at registration.

b) All boats are to be sailed by a crew of two (helmsperson and forward hand). The helmsperson and forward hand must both be financial members of the 125 Association and members of a sailing/yacht club affiliated with a State Yachting Authority.

c) The helmsperson and forward hand must both be aged eight (8) years or more at the first Heat.

d) A Division - The helmsperson and forward hand shall be designated before the start of the series. Crew changes will only be allowed under exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Race Committee. Such permission shall be given in writing.

e) B Division - Swapping of Skippers and Crews is allowed if a complete list is supplied no later than 1200hrs on Friday 2nd of April at Registration. Identification of B Division while sailing will be by positioning a (red) plastic ribbon from the second bottom batten. Note: Division B will be sailed with or without spinnakers—handicaps will be adjusted accordingly.

f) Each participating boat will be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$5,000,000. Proof of insurance is to be presented at registration.

3. ENTRIES

Entries on the prescribed "Form of Entry" attached shall be lodged with the Race Secretary on or before 5pm Friday the 26th of March, accompanied by the prescribed entry fee of \$50.00. Entries can be posted to the;

4. REGISTRATION

Registration of entries will take place at the Race Headquarters on Friday 2nd April 2010, starting approximately 900hrs and finishing at 1200hrs.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at Race Headquarters on the day.

6. SCHEDULE OF RACES

7. COURSES

Courses will be set on Hervey Bay. The courses will be Triangle courses as described in the sailing instructions.

- A Division - Triangle, Windward and Return, Triangle, Windward Finish
 B Division - Triangle, Triangle, Windward Finish

8. SCORING SYSTEM

The Low-Point Scoring System, (RRS) Rule A4 Appendix A will apply. Each boat starting and finishing in a race, and not thereafter retiring or being disqualified, will be scored points as follows. First 1, Second 2, Third 3, Forth 4, Fifth 5, each place thereafter add one point. All other boats will be scored points for the finishing place one more than the total number of boats entered in the series.

A minimum of 3 races is necessary to constitute the series. If only three (3) races are sailed all three shall count. If more than three heats are sailed each boat will discard her worst score. The lowest score wins.

9. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

The 720-degree turns penalty, Rules 44.1 and 44.2 of the racing rules will apply.
