The sailing community was very encouraging throughout the process and I thank you all for making this one unforgettable long weekend. We worked so hard and achieved the 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall handicap in Division B. To the 125 Association and the Maryborough

Yacht Club, what a great Easter weekend and I am sure I speak for all Lourdes Hill College Sailors, what a fantastic regatta.

It was a light series, but this provided some close racing and gave many of the less-experienced crews a chance because the conditions were manageable for all competitors.

The first race of the Championship was the Jan Seto Memorial Race on the Friday. This was won by Lachie & Tim Robba in 3167 'Shake n Bake'. Jan Seto was heavily involved in the 125 class, both as a sailor and a supporter. She taught many Lourdes Hill girls how to sail and was involved with Lourdes Hill College Sailing Club for many years. Jan was also an integral part of the Queensland 125 Association, offering her services to assist with the organisation of events, the promotion of the class and was the editor of this newsletter for many years. We race in her memory on Easter Friday every year.

Some stiff competition was had in B Fleet, and Dean Steinback & Maddi Norton managed to take out a win on Scratch in 3142 'Limited Edition'. B Fleet Handicap was taken out by Lourdes Hill boat '2039' Saluki. A Fleet on Scratch was taken out by Lachie & Tim Robba in their family 125 3167 'Shake n Bake' – some close racing was had with Doug Brewer & John Anderson in 3125 'J'.

Lily Geck & her crew Xanthe Walker did extremely well in their first 125 State Championships, sailing 3161 'Imagine'. After some close competitive sailing, these two girls went on to win the double  $-1^{st}$  on Handicap (A Fleet) and the Junior trophy. They also finished  $3^{rd}$  overall on Scratch! Great sailing girls!

Just prior to the regatta, 3122 'Swish' was purchased by Simon Carter for his daughter Nicole to sail. Nicole has recently come out of Sabots and has only sailed 125's a handful of times. It was great to see 'Swish' on the water at the State Championships with Nicole competently at the helm and Simon crewing for her! Nicole is already showing a great deal of potential in 125's and will be someone to watch in the future. Nicole & Simon finished 7<sup>th</sup> overall (A Fleet) and 2<sup>nd</sup> on Handicap in their first 125 regatta! Very well sailed!
