NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 and
- 1.2 The AS Special Regulations Part 2 For Off The Beach Boats 2024; and
- 1.3 The class rules of the National 125 Association; and
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions.

If there is a conflict between the Rules or Regulations, other than the RRS, the Sailing Instructions will prevail.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to members currently registered with the Queensland 125 Association.
- 2.2 All Competitors (both helm and crew) shall be financial members of the Queensland 125 Association
- 2.3 Both helm and crew shall be current financial members of Australian Sailing or affiliated to an alternative Member Nation Authority.
- 2.3 Eligible boats must be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and sending by email or post to the below.

ALL Entries are to be received no later than Monday the 15th April 2025.

2.5 Entries may be accepted up until Friday 18th April at the discretion of the QLD 125 Sailing assoc. (This is also providing that the entry fee is paid by EFT and that the sailors are current financial members of the assoc. prior to Heat 1)

3. FEES

Entry Fee: \$60 / boat.

Payments must be by direct deposit by 18th April 2025. No cash will be accepted on any day of the regatta.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1 Owners / helmspersons may be requested to present their hulls, foils, masts, spars and sails for measurement, inspection for compliance with AS Special Regulations Part 2 during the time specified prior to the Regatta and at any time during the Regatta when requested by the 125 Association Measurer or Race Committee.

5.2 Only one set of sails, one set of spars, one centreboard and one rudder are permitted to be used in the Regatta. The Race Committee may approve replacement if the original of these items is damaged beyond repair.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after 0900am Friday 18th April 2025 from the desk in the Maryborough Sailing Clubhouse, Scarness Beach.

7. Regatta Site

The Regatta will be conducted at the Maryborough Sailing Club, adjacent to the Scarness Caravan Park, Hervey Bay and sailed on the waters of Hervey Bay.

8. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters of Hervey Bay in the vicinity of the Maryborough Sailing Club Clubhouse at Scarness.

9. COURSES

All courses will be sailed in Hervey Bay from the Maryborough Sailing Club Scarness Clubhouse. Courses will be advised at the briefings.

10. SCORING

10.1 The low point system of Appendix A will apply.

10.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 When only three races can be completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores

10.4 When more than 3 races are completed, a boats worst score will be discarded.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

Spectator craft will ensure they do not interfere with any boats racing on the course.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive radio communications. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.

13. PRIZES

Perpetual trophies and prizes will be awarded as listed below and other trophies and prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority

Jan Seto Memorial – 1st Scratch Race 1

Open Championship - 1st, 2nd & 3rd

Open Handicap - 1st, 2nd & 3rd

Juniors 1st (Skipper and Crew under 18 on the 18th April 2025)

Masters 1st (Skipper over 40yrs or combination over 70yrs as of 18th April 2025)

Family Division - 1st Handicap and others at the discretion of the QLD 125 Sailing Association. (Minimum 3 entries for the Family Division to be eligible)

Brenda Steinback Memorial Trophy – 1st Handicap in Family Division or at the discretion of the Steinback Family if no Family Division.

Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the QLD 125 Sailing Association.

14. DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in this Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Maryborough Sailing Club, the QLD 125 assoc, their members, officers or sponsors, and all others involved in the conduct and management of this event, shall not be liable for any loss of life or injury, or for the loss of property or damage thereto, whatsoever or howsoever occurring. ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO RRS4 which states:

“The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.”.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 Million. **Entrants must supply a copy of current insurance certificate with entry form.**
